Successful record for the use of ReelCloud in lectures

Bonn, July 30, 2020.

Prof. Dr. Gesmann-Nuissl from the Chair of Private Law and Intellectual Property Law at Chemnitz University of Technology gives a successful review of the use of ReelCloud for live streaming with ReelCloud in the summer semester 2020.

The Chair of Private Law and Intellectual Property Law of Prof. Dr. Gesmann-Nuissl at Chemnitz University of Technology relied on the combination of ReelCloud and the OPAL learning platform in the summer semester 2020.

Via a course created in the OPAL learning platform, the approximately 100 students received the web address (URL) of the livestream produced with ReelCloud. ReelCloud hosted the website, which was designed in the corporate design of the department and equipped with ReelCloud's adaptive streaming player, in a European data center. The streaming player made it possible to play the livestream in different resolutions - depending on the available bandwidth at the students' sites.

Both the direct integration of the PowerPoint presentations and the communication with the students via the (data) protected forum function of the (lecture) course in OPAL worked smoothly. All lectures are stored in ReelCloud for documentation and post-processing.

"All high-resolution livestreams of the lectures worked smoothly," Prof. Dr. Gesmann-Nuissl was pleased to report at the end of the semester. And livestreaming via ReelCloud's cloud servers in the European data centers relieved the university's computing infrastructure for the other conference systems used at the university. "Another positive factor was the high resolution of the system used, which meant that even small details on the slides used were easy to read," said Prof. Gesmann-Nuissl.
